- Review Parent Survey Goals from 2020 2021

Principal Acosta shared the three surveys that are distributed annually and how the data is used. She reminded everyone that the Parent Engagement Survey goes out next week. She discussed Robey's highest score from last year - My family is treated with respect at school. Robey received a score of 4.6 and the goal is to maintain that. Some commitments are: Principal will send monthly newsletter to families, teachers will send weekly updates specific to their class, phone calls and reports will be sent in a timely

manner, a translator is available for our Spanish-speaking families, and parents will be invited to learn more through Title I nights.

Our lowest performance indicator was #13 - I received positive calls, emails, notes, about my child from school - 3.92. The goal is to increase this number to 4.2. Staff commitments are to send personal emails, notes monthly; keep an accurate record of contact with guardians; continue to use student data binders to be able to share information; send home progress reports or letters about what interventions are being used; and what the academic focus is from week-to-week. Principal Acosta will send monthly newsletters.

Mrs. Fetters stated that she appreciates the communication and that more education helps parents and teachers.

Mrs. Flanders stated that it is never a burden to tell a parent how great their child is.

Ms. Acosta asked parents what data is important to know.

Mr. Jones stated that it is best to keep it simple and direct and include the child's score and the average class score to know whether a child is high or low.

Ms. Acosta stated that the parent and student surveys will be coming out next week. These surveys are very important as they are looked at very carefully when preparing action steps.

- Discuss Tax Credit Funding
